

This sturdy little spiral-bound book (57 pages) lives up to its name! I was blown away. The best description I can give you is it's the *Advanced Placement* edition of ***Stitches to Go***. I kid you not. The book is small enough to fit in your stitching bag (11" x 4") with very few of the "usual suspects" you'd expect in a book of this ilk. Instead, you have nearly 20 variations on the Rhodes, 10+ Jessicas, a Stacked Open Lazy Daisy that would make an ideal tiny Menorah, a few blackwork offerings, and several Rhodes, just to name a few. Many of these I've never seen, and can't wait to try. The best feature of this book is that each page of stitches is on the left. On the right is graph paper that truly replicates canvas weave. If you're inspired to design your own stitch, you're all set. Now, where'd I put that pencil?
