

This compact, spiral bound book is small enough to fit into a large needlework carry bag. The book's format is rather unusual; no color photos, and no table of contents. It has a very good index, however. Rev. Blackburn's stitch commentaries make for interesting reading. This book would be an asset in the needlework library of anyone who loves to do counted needlepoint, or who is looking for unusual pattern stitches. Rev. Blackburn concludes the book with a series of 12 Asian-inspired "Diaper Patterns" that would make stunning accents to any décor. Definitely worth a look!
